

# Tourmaline & Thyme Quilts

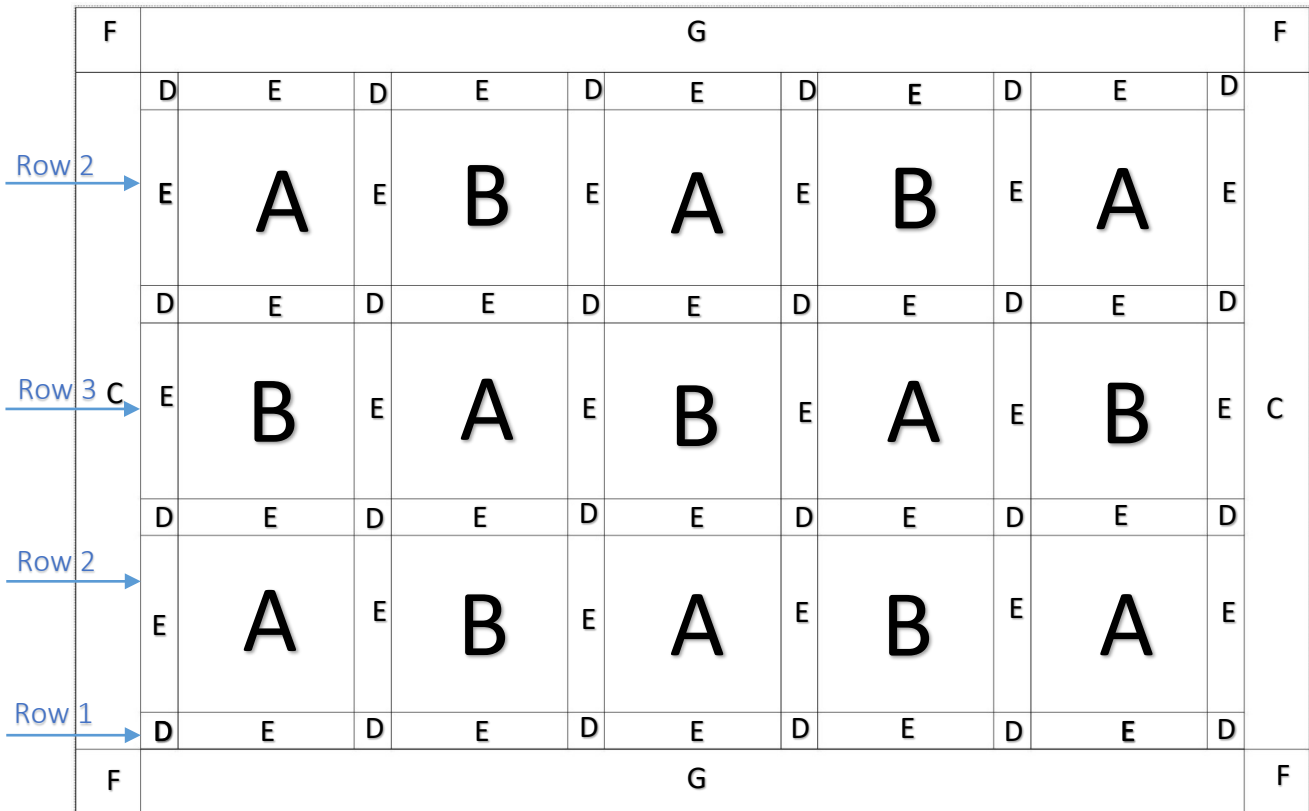


## Materials

Featured in Wine Nights by Mary Beth Baker for Henry Glass ([www.henryglassfabrics.net/fabric-lines/all-collections/wine-night/](http://www.henryglassfabrics.net/fabric-lines/all-collections/wine-night/)) but any 8 block fabric (with 9 1/2 inch blocks) will work.

### Cutting Instructions

**Fabric 1** (Wine Nights - Blocks Black Panel)

Fussy cut eight 10" squares. (Block A).

**Fabric 2** (Wine Nights - Wine Seals Black Multi)

Cut two 10" strips width of fabric (WOF).

**Fabric 3** (Wine Nights – Packed Bottles Black Multi)

Cut two 62" x 4" strips and two 40" x 4" strips (unpieced border) OR

Cut six 4" strips if piecing border.

**Fabric 4** (Wine Nights – Words Tone on Tone Mustard)

Cut two 2 1/2" strips WOF.

Cut one 2 1/2" square from one of the strips (Block D).

**Fabric 5** (Wine Nights - Words Tone on Tone Red)

Cut two 10" strips WOF.

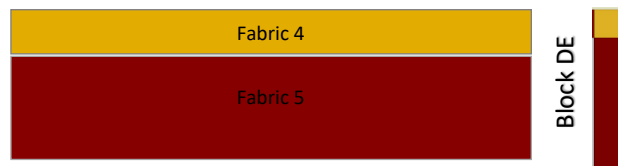
Cut four 4" squares (Block F).

Cut eight 2 1/2" x 10" rectangles (Block E).

### Assembly

Use 1/4" seam when sewing. Tack or pin intersecting seams to keep corners clean.

1. Sew each strip of Fabric 4 to a strip Fabric 5. Repeat to create two larger strips (Strip 4-5).



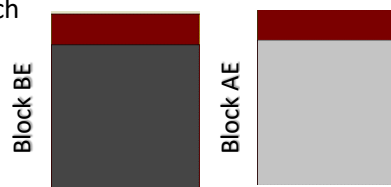
2. Cut the Strip 4-5 into twenty-three 2 1/2" strips (23 Blocks DE, which measure 2 1/2" x 12").

3. Sew five Block DE together and one Block D. This will form Row 1.

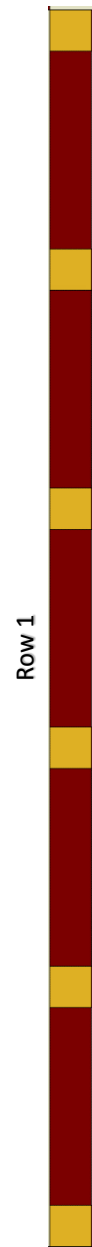
4. Sew a strip of Fabric 5 to a strip Fabric 4. Repeat to create two larger strips (Strip 5-2).



5. Cut the Strip 5-2 into seven 10" strips (7 Blocks BE, which measure 10" x 12").

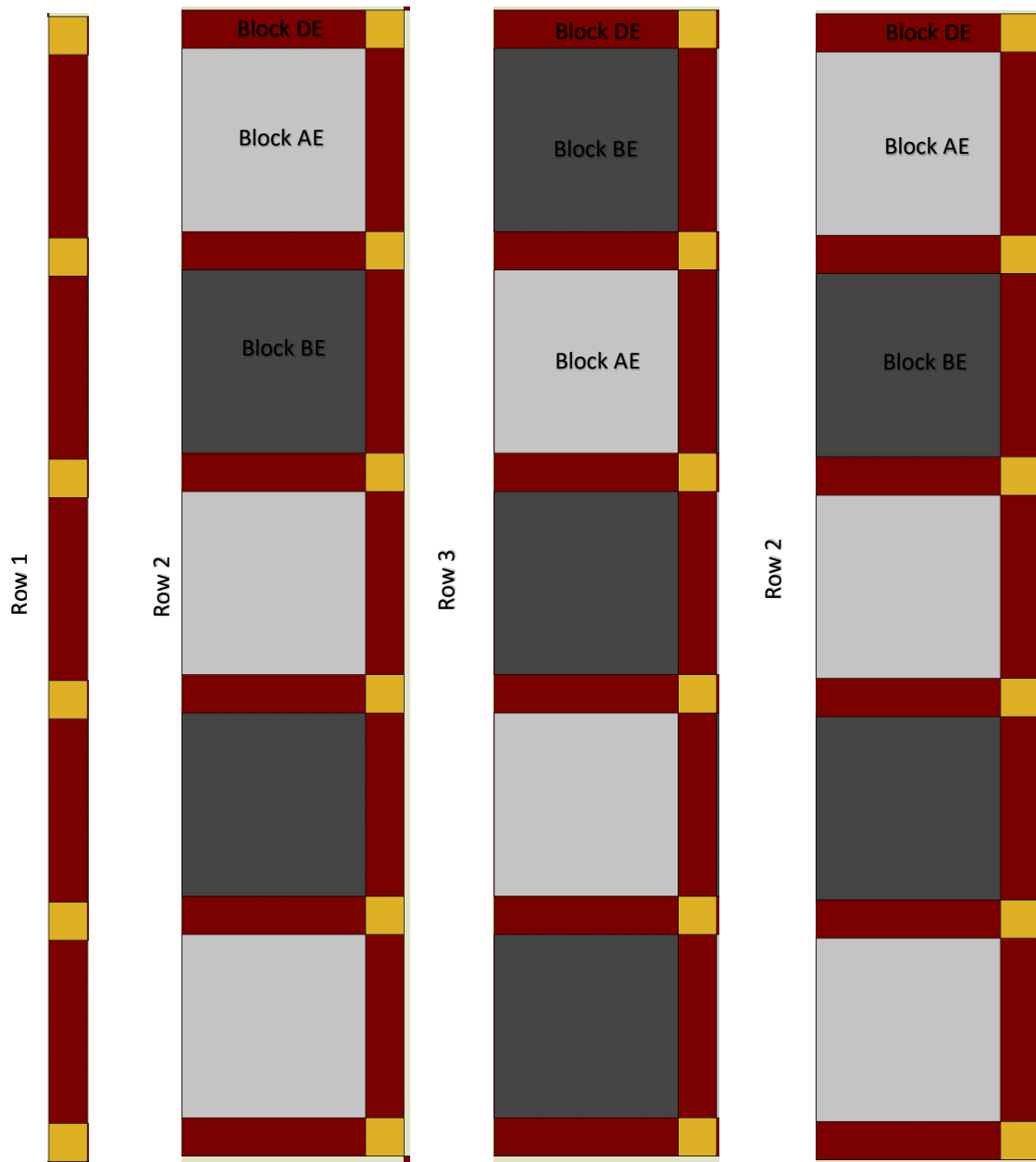


6. Sew Blocks A to Blocks E to make eight Blocks AE, which measure 10" x 12".



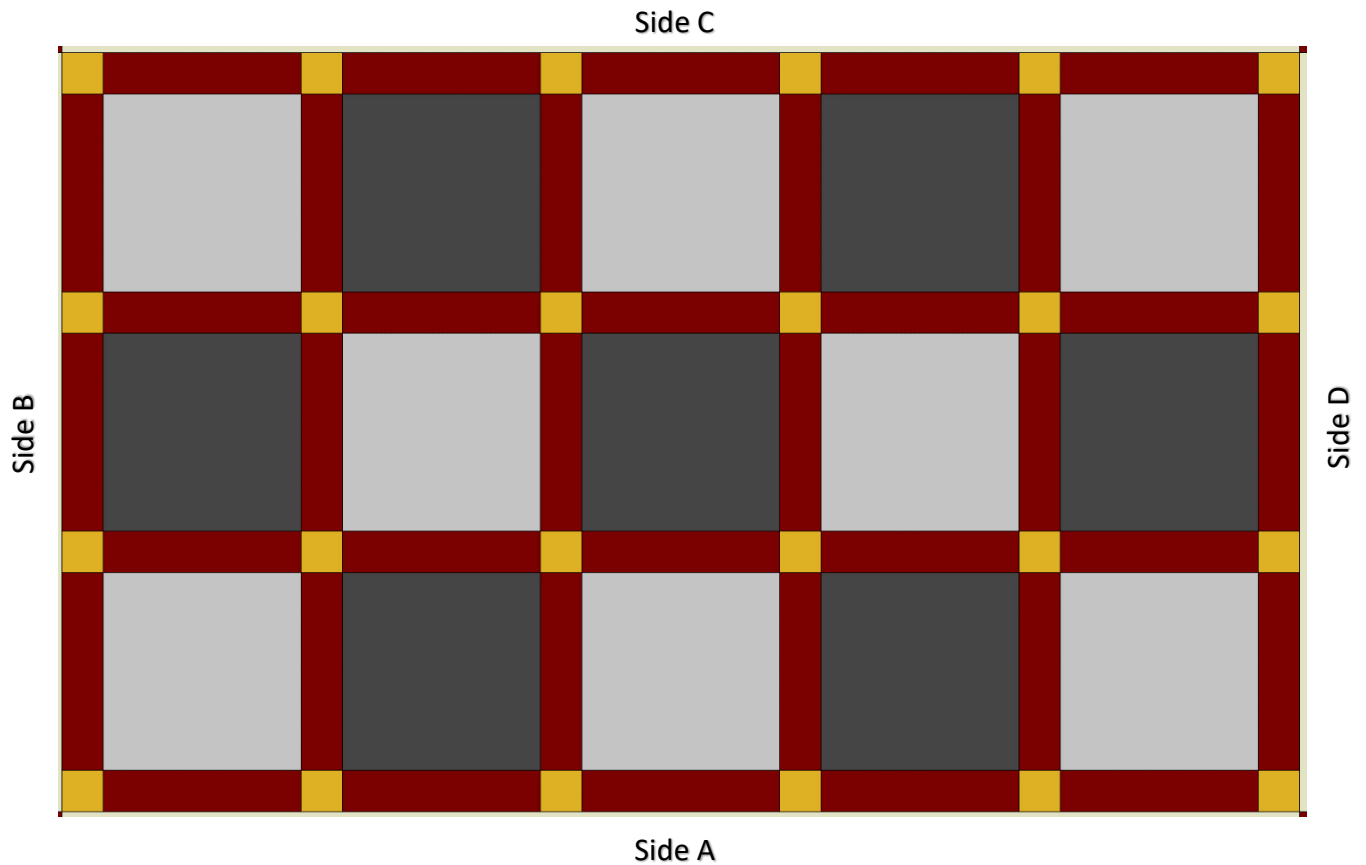


7. For two Row 2, sew together blocks three Block AE, two Block BE and six Block DE (see diagram below).
8. For one Row 3, sew together blocks three Block BE, two Block AE and six Block DE (see diagram below).
9. Sew together rows in the following order: Row 1 – Row 2 – Row 3 – Row 2 (see diagram below). This will form the quilt center.





10. Measure the length of each side. The quilt center should be  $59\frac{1}{2}'' \times 36\frac{1}{2}''$ . If it is a little off that is ok, so long as the opposite sides (A-C and B-D) are equal.



11. Cut the longest sash pieces (Piece G) to equal Side A and Side C. It should be  $59''$ . If not, match the measured length.
12. Attach sash piece (G) to Side A and Side C of the quilt center.
13. Cut the longest sash pieces (Piece C) to equal Side B and Side D. It should be  $38''$ . If not, match the measured length.
14. Sew Piece F to each end of Piece C to make two sash pieces (Block FCF).
15. Sew Blocks FCF onto Side B and Side D to complete the quilt top.
