

PTN3049 Wings Outside My Window

Cutting Instructions:



DP25140-42 Eagle Stripe

• Cut four 8 ¼- ¾-inch x WOF Length of Fabric strips. **Subcut** two 8 ¼- ¾-inch x 29 ½-inch Strips and two 8 ¼- ¾-inch x 42 ½-inch Strips. (**Border 1**)



DP25146-95 Rock Texture

• Cut four 1-inch x WOF of fabric strips. Sew strips together end to end. Subcut two 1-inch x 29 ½-inch Strips and two 1-inch x 42 ½-inch Strips. (Border 1)

Quilt Assembly

4) Eagle Stripe Border 1.

a) Sew Rock Texture 1-inch strip to top of each Eagle Stripe 8 ¼-inch strip, matching lengths, to make Eagle Stripe 8 ¾-inch strips. (New Step)

IF you have already cut your fabric before you find these corrections, do NOT panic.

Please follow these instructions.

Trim the QST and squares for the star to 3" instead of 3 $\frac{1}{4}$ ". Sew the star together. This should be an 8" star (with seam allowances).

Now, trim the border print to 8" width. The lengths will be the same as provided in the pattern. The quilt with these borders will now be $57 \frac{1}{2}$ " x $44 \frac{1}{2}$ ".

The final border strips should be cut to 3 1/2" x 44 1/2" and 3 1/2" x 63 1/2". This will make the quilt dimensions 63 1/2" x 50 1/2".
