



## TTQ-406 – Pattern Clarification:

The Sash pieces should be  $4\frac{1}{2}'' \times 12\frac{1}{2}''$  (unfinished). Enlarge the foundation as needed to ensure it is the appropriate size. Most printers are set to FIT, so the foundation will be smaller than designed. We have found that setting the printer/copier to approximately 102% works for many printers.

If you have already made your sash pieces and they are smaller than designed. Measure the width of the sash. If it is  $4\frac{3}{8}''$ , then trim all of your  $4\frac{1}{2}''$  pieces and HST to  $4\frac{3}{8}''$ . That will make the quilt about  $2\frac{1}{8}''$  smaller, but an additional border, can bring it back to size.

If the sash is  $4\frac{1}{4}''$ , then trim all of your  $4\frac{1}{2}''$  pieces and HST to  $4\frac{1}{4}''$ . That will make the quilt about  $4\frac{1}{4}''$  smaller.

Third Bullet of Step 4 should say

- Fold on **A/C** line. Trim **Piece A/B**. Place **Piece C** on top of **Piece B**, RST. Sew the pieces together and press the piece open.
